
THE ADVENTURES OF TOM SAWYER


He had a wife, and four children, and died in 1910.

Twain photographed in 1908 by a special type of shooting in colour, called the Autochrome Lumiere process.




CHAPTER 1: THE FENCE




CHAPTER 4.: ACROSS THE RIVER




CHAPTER 8.: BECKY'S ADVENTURE DAY

CHAPTER 10.: IN THE CAVE


